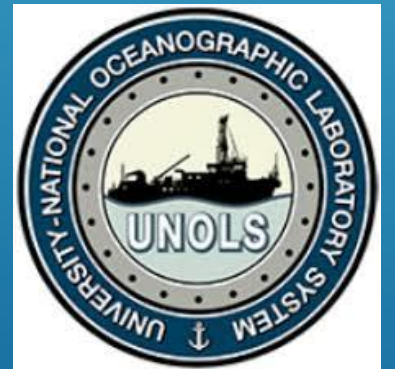

- ▶ ADCPs (UHDAS), Patch Test- SeaPath, SIS- Kongsberg, QPS, Serial Comms

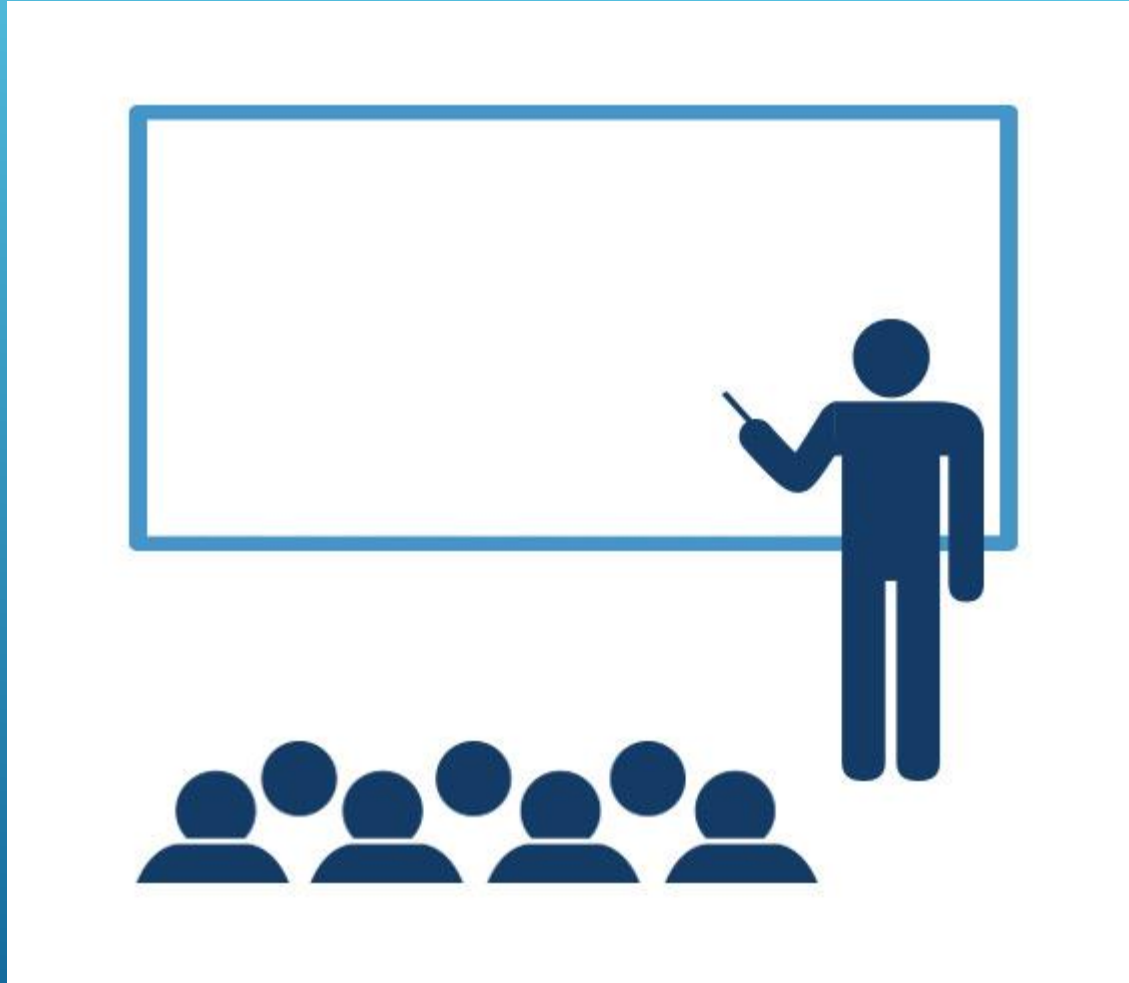
- ▶ **BIOS Hosted Seabird Training**
