




2020 R & M rebuild and upgrades

- Science, equipment, tooling & sensors


> <u>Upgrades</u>

- New 6000m Umbilical (Currently Spare)
- Replaced all ROV oil filled trunk cables
- Rewired all ROV junction boxes & installed new PCB's
- > Oil / Water Separator (Feb 2021)
- Science tooling & topside integration upgrades
- Built a Vibracore (1.5m cores)

2020 Cruise Highlights

- Maintained Offshore Operations as best as possible despite the Global COVID 19 Pandemic
 - Discovered a massive detached coral reef over 500m high.
 - Viewed the deepest regions of the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park.
 - Discovered five undescribed species consisting of black corals and sponges &150-foot siphonophore-seemingly the longest animal ever recorded.
 - First recorded live observation of Spirula, aka ram's horn squid, alive and in its natural environment.
