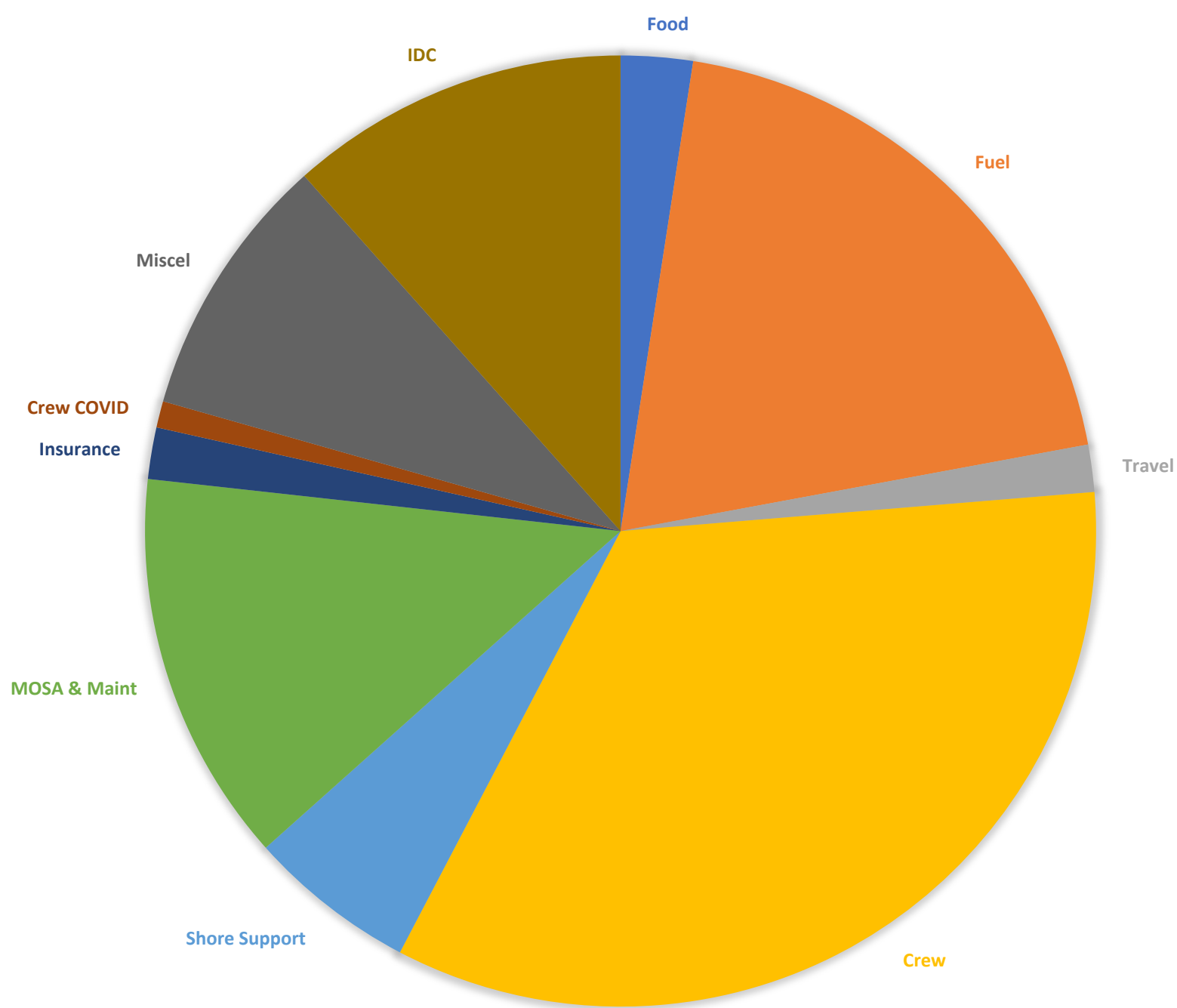


U.S. Academic Research Fleet

- FY 2022 Annual Report Negotiations underway. A few operators have been fully funded
- IPS does not have the full FY 22 budget allocation yet
- CY 2023 is the start of the New 5-year cooperative agreements. This fall your SROs will be asked to negotiate new T&C. Please be thinking of items you think should be include the new T&C
- Next year's GEO/OCE budget will ask for a 19% increase for ARF– but this is very early in the budget process
- Divestment process underway for R/V *Oceanus*
- Renewal process underway for *Sikuliaq*
- Crewing issues have been elevated to NSF Chief facilities Office
- Bahama's research clearance embargo continues
