Engineering Update

- Completed a \$14.9 million, six-month dry dock at Mare Island Dry Dock in Vallejo, CA on May 17th
- Necessary maintenance or replacement of major science gear work items including transducers, winches, and cranes
- Replace multi beam replace with Kongsberg EM 124
- Conducted overhaul on 3 of 4 Main Diesel Generators
- Other major dry dock/inport work items:
 - Painted underwater body, red freeboard and sides of superstructure
 - Overhauled bow thruster, steering and rudder
 - Significant crew habitability upgrades
 - CGOne and RDC/PSN Starlink installations
