

SIO CHALLENGES AND SUCCESSES SINCE LAST RVOC



Revelle: DG3 Failure

Our CAT C32 came violently apart on Sept 19

Investigation tediously slow (waiting for CAT)



Revelle: Shaft Seal Failure

•Noticed leak from PS, but confirmed SB to be degrading in same manner.

·Liners with metallurgic specialist, awaiting attendance wartsila



Revelle: Inverter failure

•Failed at sea after drydock. Unrelated to the shaft seal issue. Capacitor bank in blue drive was "blown up"

•New inverter flown out to vessel and installed on Dec 21



RG Sproul drydock

•Extensive steelwork, longer drydock than expected

•Back in operation after more than 3 months (while anticipating less than a month)

•When back in operation, immediately hammered with a hydraulic leak in a ballast tank.
