

Senior Science Manager

The Senior Science Manager is a full-time, salaried position within the Sustainable Seafood Initiative at Monterey Bay Aquarium's Division of Conservation Outreach. The incumbent is responsible for the overall scientific approach of the Seafood Watch Program through the development and implementation of the program's scientific framework for sustainable capture fisheries and aquaculture. The position oversees the scientific analysis and decision-making process for consumers and major seafood buyers, supervises the program's Fishery and Aquaculture Managers and the Research Coordinator, collaborates with external colleagues on a diversity of sustainability issues and acts as a primary spokesperson for the Monterey Bay Aquarium on the science and policy of sustainable seafood.
