

Chief Engineer needed for the R/V DAN MOORE (Cape Fear Community College's 85', 600HP student training vessel)

Time periods: June 6-10, June 13-17, June 20-24. (or just the last 2 weeks if unable to work the first week).

Minimum certification needed is a USCG license as Chief Engineer or Designated Duty Engineer for vessels of 1000 horsepower.

Pay will be approximately \$1,300 per week.

Duties include engine room watch standing during student training voyages. The voyages leave Wilmington, NC on Monday mornings, arrive in Beaufort, NC for an overnight on Wednesday, then return to Wilmington at mid-day on Friday. The full-time assistant engineer is well acclimated to the plant and its management and will provide guidance on the particulars of the operation.

The regular chief engineer is out on medical leave.
