Washington, D.C., November 18, 1976

A meeting of the ALPHA HELIX Review Committee was held November 18, 1976 at Washington, D.C., in NSF conference room 1224. A list of attendees follows these minutes.

Minutes of the ALPHA HELIX Executive Subcommittee which met at Scripps September 29, 1976, were adopted, without changes.

As a result of the above meeting, portions of the "Guidelines for Management Oversight of R/V ALPHA HELIX" had been re-written to clarify meaning. The new version, dated November 18, 1976, was adopted.
