Dear Dr. Atkinson:

I would like to take this opportunity to update the Fleet Improvement Committee on the status of the *CAPE HENLOPEN Replacement Vessel*:

- Four proposals were received (out of the eight pre-qualified shipyards) on August 29th.
- Total cost was slightly higher than expected. However, proposals were competitive and pricing relatively tight for a ship construction project.
- We are currently in the 90-day shipyard evaluation process and cannot discuss precise cost details at this time.
- We have been instructed by the University of Delaware Leadership to proceed toward yard selection and contract negotiation.
- Contract signing is currently projected for November.

Though we are slightly behind on shipyard selection, the construction and delivery targets remain as originally projected.
