


Some Precipitation Characteristics of Seattle

Median Rainfall: 33.8 inches, similar to Dallas, Kansas City, Chicago, Cleveland; about half of Miami, New Orleans

Rainy Hours: 11% annually, 22% in January, <3% in July

Drizzle or Rain: 72.5% drizzle (< .02 inches/hour), 1.5% heavy rain (>.16 inches/hour).
