



Budget Authority

- OSTP/OMB shifted budget authority for the polar icebreaking program from USCG to NSF starting in FY06.
- NSF and USCG are operating under an Aug 2005 MOA that provides guidance for the transfer of funds.
- NSF identifies icebreaker mission needs to USCG by 1 Jun.
- USCG submits Program Plan for maintenance, operations and personnel to NSF by 1 Jul.
- Negotiation period for approval of Program Plan by 30 Sep.



Budget Authority

- USCG is seeking return of budget authority to clearly align budget responsibility and operational authority.
- During last AICC meeting USCG was working with OMB to facilitate return of budget authority.
- Mar 2008 NSC/HSC Deputies Committee meeting attended by Commandant resulted in tasker for MS PCC to evaluate and submit report.
- Interagency report submitted for follow-on Deputies
 Committee meeting to be scheduled.
- Return of budget authority would likely require new MOA.



Budget Authority

- Current budget arrangement is not 100% reimbursable but USCG cannot legally supplement NSF's appropriation.
- USCG cannot receive reimbursements from other agenices by MOA reimbursements (NOAA, ONR) must go through NSF.
- NSF hired Jamestown Marine Services (JMS) to provide independent review of USCG polar icebreaker maintenance.
- JMS report is positive endorsement of current maintenance practices - no recommendations to remove items from current maintenance plan and some recommendations to accelerate work, particularly system recapitalization.
