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# **Terms of Reference**

- Focus on shared-use federal assets for ORPP implementation
- Structured around a data call to the agencies
- Shared-use assets include federally-owned and/or federally-operated facilities and infrastructure
- Two phase study Initial efforts focused on phase 1 only
- Coordinate with JSOST
- Coordinate with proposed OSB infrastructure study

# Phase 1 - TOR

- Develop guiding principles for determining shared-use facilities for ORPP
- Used guiding principles for agency data call
  - Retired assets awaiting disposition
  - Operating assets
  - Assets under construction
  - Assets proposed in FY09 budget
  - Assets in conceptual stage under consideration
- Resolve ambiguities
- Use data call to define trends, areas of diminishing or increasing capability/capacity
- Report, including recommendations for use in budget development

# Phase 2 - TOR

- Contingent on results from phase 1
- Integrate agency plans
- Identify priority areas necessary for ORPP implementation
- Identify priority gaps and issues
- Develop "facilities and infrastructure implementation strategy"

## **Status**

- IWG-F held one full meeting
- Second meeting scheduled for early Oct
- Status and way forward briefed to JSOST guidance to focus on ORPP research priorities within six themes
- Intent is complete initial inventory early CY2009
- Organization and initial data call underway, but is problematic

## **JSOST Suggestion:**

• IWG-F modify approach to defining the "guiding principles" - use the Research Priorities identified in the ORPP as the basic framework for the guiding principles

# Way Ahead

- Begin with the four Near-Term Priorities identified in the ORPP
  - Work with the agency leads responsible for the Near-Term Priorities to initiate the process
  - Deciding which tools are necessary, concentrating on those inventories first
- Expand data call to 20 research priorities identified in the six themes
  - Modify matrix as appropriate based on lessons learned from four Near-Term Priorities

## **Initial Matrix – The way ahead**

- Details the four priorities and the tools necessary to implement them
  - Built using the information in the ORPP, NOT meant to be all inclusive
- Work with the team leads to fully develop and populate the matrix
- Develop an initial inventory of common (shareduse) and unique facilities and infrastructure needs for the Near-Term Priorities.
