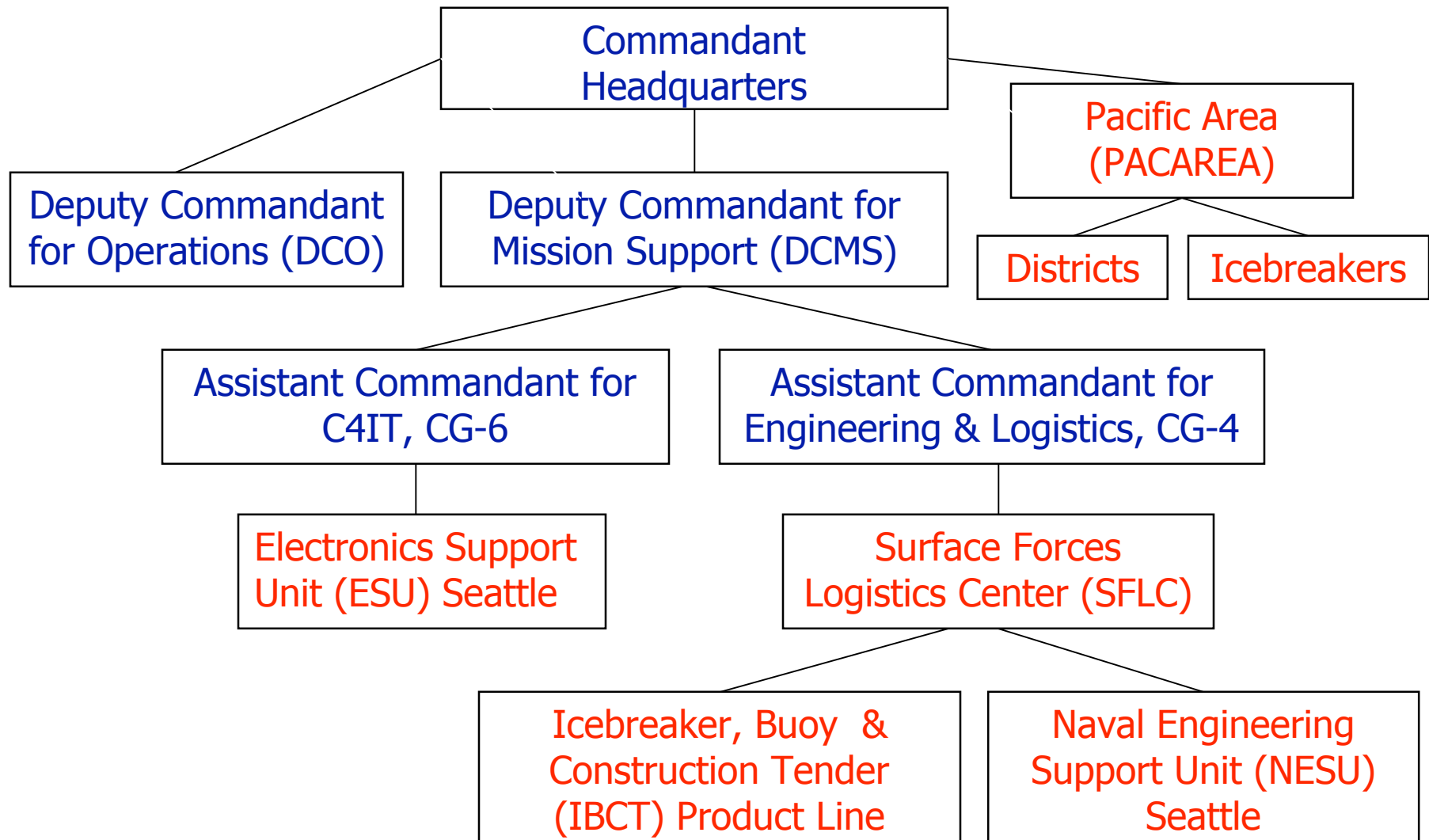

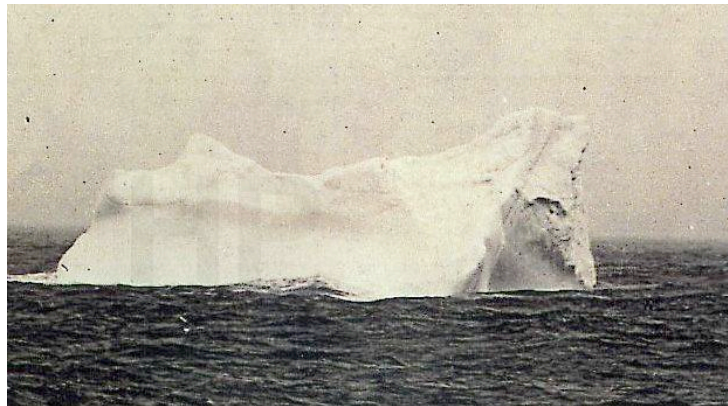

PRIORITIES

- **Return of budget authority including revised Memorandum of Agreement with the National Science Foundation**
- **Recapitalization**
 - POLAR STAR reactivation
 - High-latitude study ongoing to determine requirements
 - New acquisition or service-life extension project
- **Communication/coordination**
 - Internal – HQ/PACAREA/SFLC
 - Interagency – NSF, NIC, NOAA, USN, etc.
 - Support of Coast Guard and other agency Arctic initiatives
