



USCG Priorities

1. Permanent return of budget authority including revised Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with NSF

FY10:

- -Congress directed NSF to transfer funds to CG
- -CG and NSF signed MOA for FY10 only

FY11:

- -NSF retains budget authority in FY11 budget
- -CG and NSF agreed to follow 2005 MOA
- -Congress may direct NSF to transfer funds to CG
- -CG and NSF finalizing long-term MOA for permanent return



USCG Priorities

2. Recapitalization

POLAR STAR reactivation

- -Add 7-10 years of service life
- -Bridging strategy to maintain heavy icebreaking capability
- -Operational in late 2012

High-latitude study and polar icebreaker mission analysis report

- -Determine CG and polar icebreaker mission requirements
- -Due in June

Business case analysis

- -Analysis of new acquisition or service-life extension options
- -Due in June
