Assumptions for 2010

- CH2MHill Polar Services (CPS) partnering with BTS & BASC via a subcontract
- Provide ship to shore & land operations for science participants on the cruise that they want/need
- Require prior authorization & final details three weeks in advance
- Short notice requests provided pending approval & resources

Potential Scope of Support for a Project

- Meals & Lodging
- Cargo handling in Barrow
- Passenger on load and off loads (airport or lodging destinations)
- Comms. for observer and logistic personnel on land
- CPS Barrow on-site Project Manager
- Assist in permitting and dialogue with AEWC, BWCA
- Community and or Marine Mammal Observers when required
- Facilitate outreach to the Barrow community
- Continue to investigate landing craft possibilities

Current Plans for September, 2010

- Dr. Pickart crew arrives Barrow Sept. 5 or 6th
- Shuttled from airport to NARL campus for food and lodging
- Embark for Healy from Search and Rescue Hangar 9-6 to 9-8
(transported from NARL to airport)
- Dr. Edwards crew disembarks Healy 9-6 to 9-8, responsible for all food, lodging and transportation needs
- USCG responsible for reservations, food and lodging; transportation provided between SAR hangar, Alaska Air and lodging
