#### Progress since December meeting...

- → Finalized Chief Scientist tutorial and added to IceFloe.
- → Developed plans for expedited installation of T/S/pCO<sub>2</sub> system on *Healy*.
- → Developed plans for van relocation on *Healy*.
- → Developed procedures for storage and tracking of hazardous materials.
- → Continued to improve process of transferring cruise information to Alaska Native groups.
- → Recommended decision from NSF on new ship tech support contract.
- → Signed formal agreement between USCG and UNOLS for shipboard tech training.

#### **Action Items**

- → Assess responsibility for logistics when operating through Nome or other ports outside the Barrow region.
- → Follow through on install of *Healy* pCO2 system for use on summer 2011Mathis cruise (Chayes).
- → Decide whether to store TSE mooring winch at WHOI or SIO (NSF).
- → Decide on and publish formal data release policy (Forcucci).
- → Discussion of NIC and ice imagery issues (Perovich, Frey).
- → Review and update *Healy* data release policies (CG, AICC).
- → Finalize decisions on *Healy* van relocation on (CG, AICC).
- → Evaluate *Healy* UPS replacement goals and procedure (CG, AICC).

#### Action Items (cont'd)

- → Update berthing information and get it onto IceFloe (Mayer).
- → Clarify role of the MSO prior to versus during cruises.
- → Finalize a decision on whether or not to keep on-deck electronic "scoreboards" (AICC).
- → Get a description of on-ice operational procedures, emphasizing safety issues, onto IceFloe (Perovich).
- → Continue development of Alaska native participants program, and post appropriate information on IceFloe (Mathis).
- → Set goals and agenda for visit with Admiral in Alameda (Muench, Alberts, CG).

### **Ongoing Concerns**

- → Modifications/clarifications of cruise planning form on IceFloe.
- → Science equipment MOA between NSF and USCG.
- → Science logistics support to cover e.g. radioisotope use.
- → Service and maintenance contracts e.g. -80° freezers.
- → Clarification/coordination of interactions among foreign vessel ops, US-DOS and Alaska Native communities.
- → Evolution of medical screening process.
- → Development of a plan for assuring *Polar Star* science capabilities (CG, AICC, NSF).
