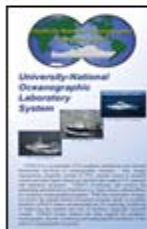
[Slide Package 1](#) - UNOLS Organization and UNOLS Fleet General Overview: This package can be adapted for general public use as well as class lectures.
