 - Two cold van (OCE)
- Office of Polar Programs
 - One general purpose van (OPP)
 - One isotope van (OPP)

Where Are We Now

East coast van pool

- Existing vans complement
 - Three general purpose vans
 - Four isotope vans
 - 3-20ft
 - 1-10ft (located @ LOMCON)
 - Two cold vans
 - One clean van
 - One wet general purpose van
