Scheduling Meeting- La Jolla, Jan. 30-31, 2014

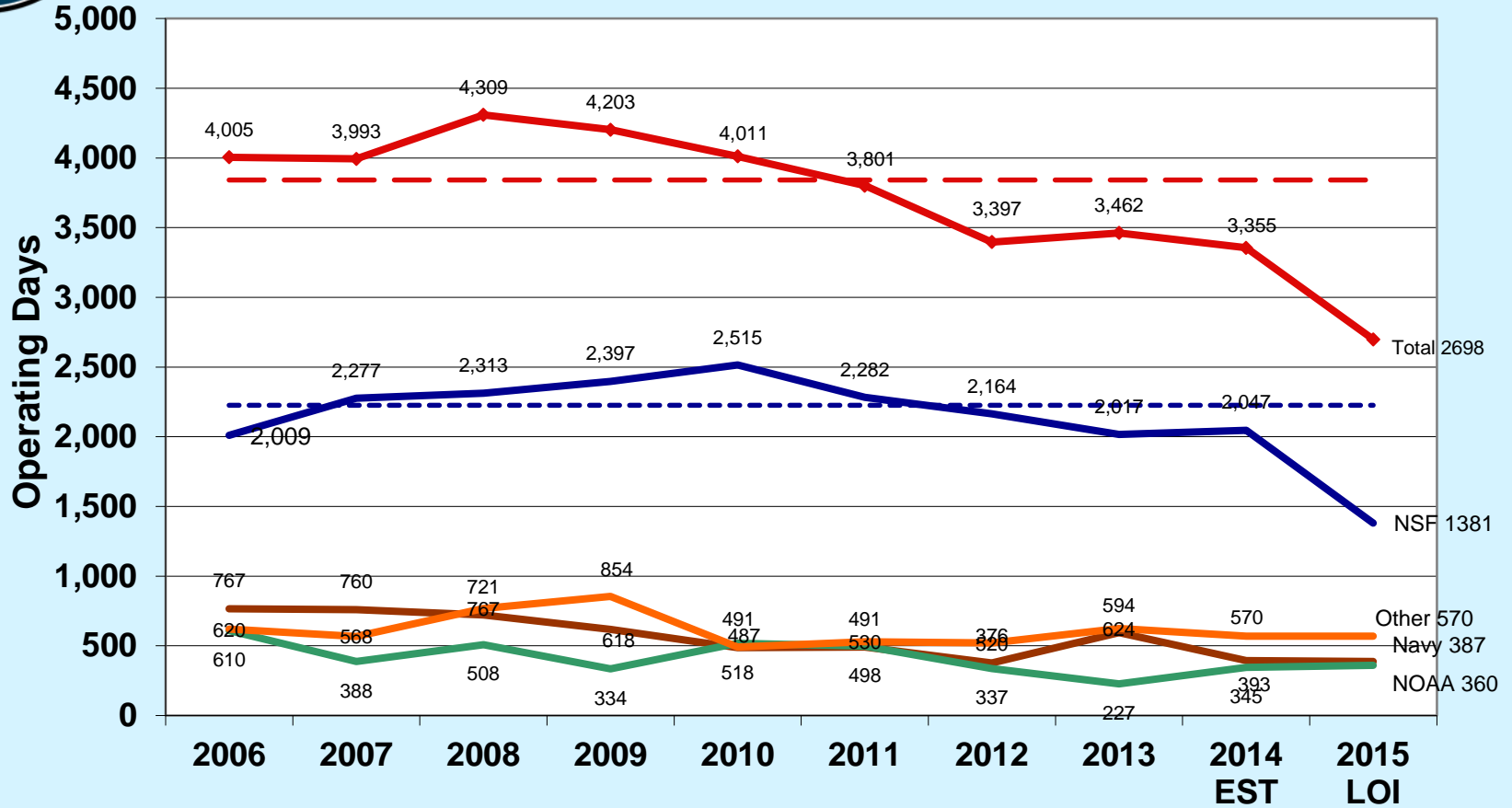

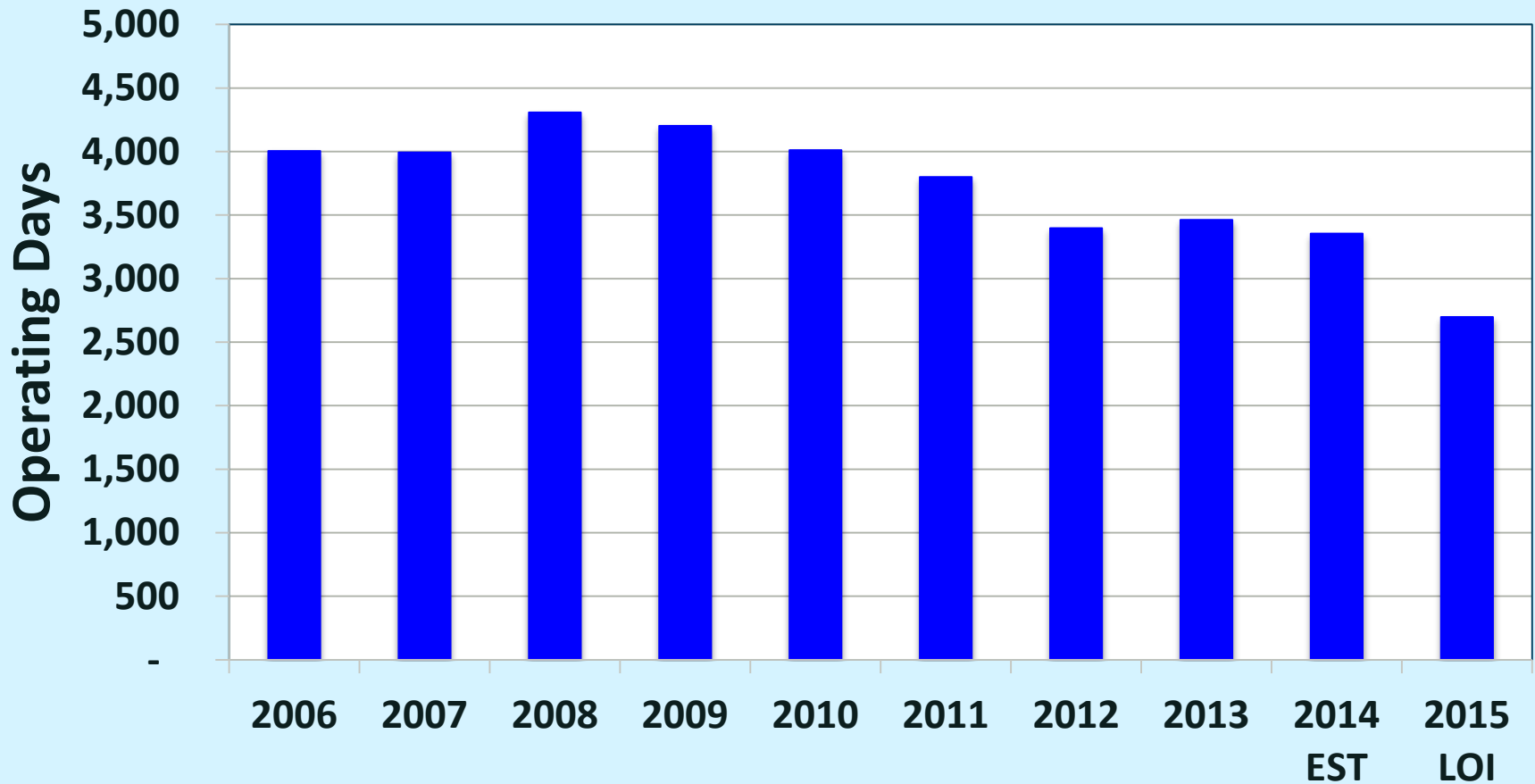


UNOLS Fleet Utilization (2006 - 2015)



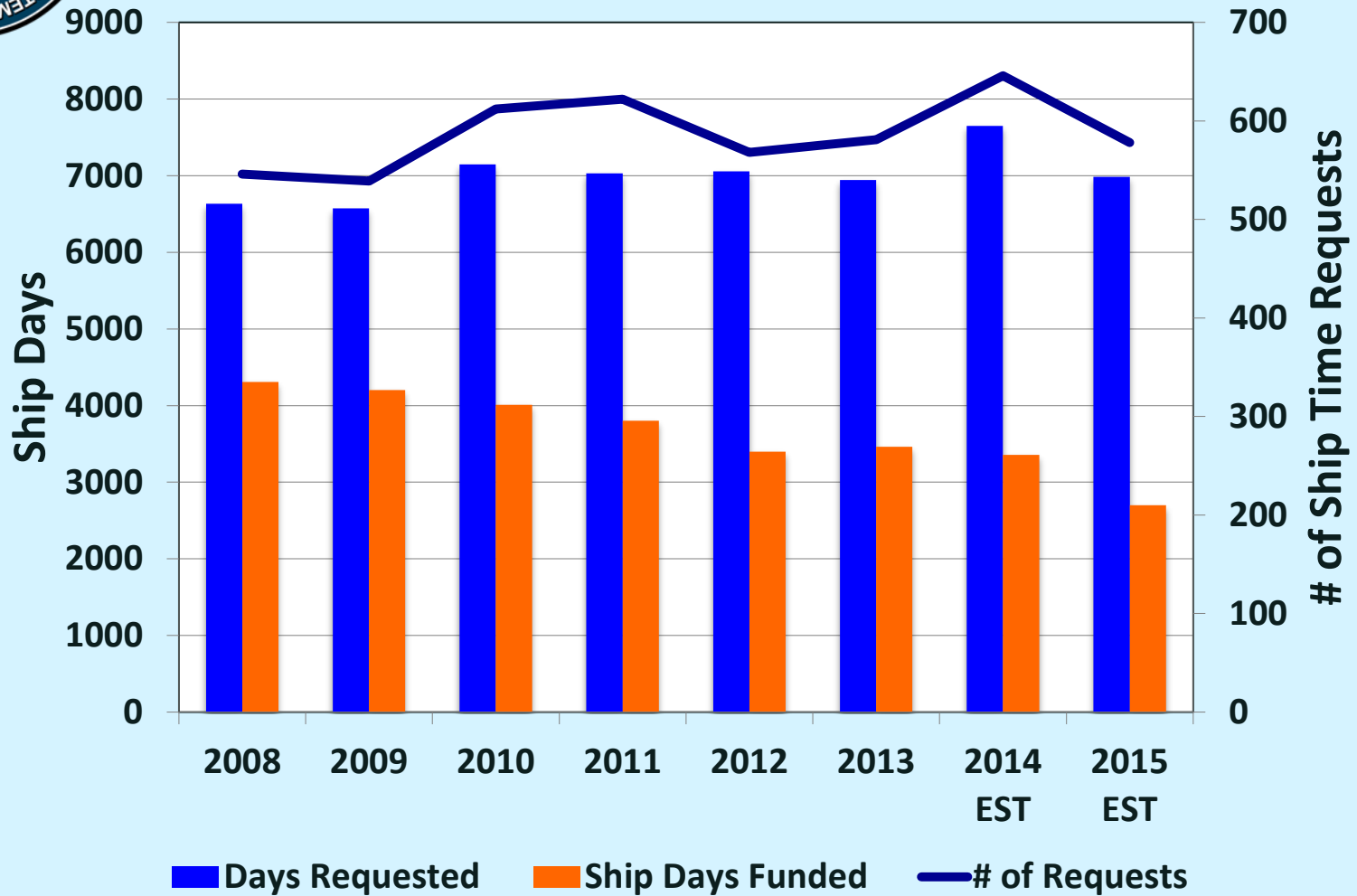


Ship Days Funded
