
- Green Ships and Ports Workshop, January 2014 Hosted by GSO with support from UNOLS



UNOLS Ship Days Funded






UNOLS Early Career Activities

 Vlahos (2), Hardy (1), Thornton (1), Bench (1), Thrash (1), Bush (1), Osborn (1)




UNOLS Early Career Activities

R/V *Sikuliaq* (Global Class Ship) entered service in Fall 2014. Currently undergoing sea trials.





Two new Ocean Class Ships:

R/V Neil Armstrong (WHOI) and R/V Sally Ride (SIO) were christened in 2014 and will enter UNOLS service in 2016



Regional Class Research Vessels

- Project Management OSU.
- March 2015- NSF request to Congress for FY17 MREFC funds.
- Up to 3 vessels will be built based on projected science demand and availability of funds.
- Operator selection is planned for mid-2017.
- First ship enters service in 2021
