




UNOLS Fleet News – Vessel Retirements

- New Horizon retired in 2015








UNOLS Fleet News - Design and Construction activities

 2016





- Regional Class Research Vessels

UNOLS Fleet Utilization






Medical Questions/Medical History Form/Pregnancy at Sea


Issues:

- In May-July 2015, the UNOLS office has received e-mails and comments from the community that the policies regarding pregnant women as members of cruise science parties could be more clearly stated and readily accessible.






