ROV JASON

- new ROV launch and recovery system = improved safety, efficiency
- There was one bad recovery (wireline nearly severed)



- WHOI and other operators are working to improve communications, coordination
- ROV JASON has been updated to better service the ocean observing systems

- Busy schedule
- Some ongoing upgrades will improve battery life; performance; user experience
