Report to the UNOLS Council UNOLS FLEET IMPROVEMENT COMMITTEE May 2016

There is also a recent FIC initiative regarding Science Mission Requirements for global-class research ships. This work will be overseen by a FIC subcommittee consisting of Clare Reimers, Jim Swift, and Greg Cutter.

- discussion of work on R/V Kilo Moana,
- polar icebreaker status,
- discussion of R/V Langseth and the MLSOC/FIC liaison,
- ROV and launch-and-recovery system performance updates,
- winch requirements, and
- telepresence guidelines.
