



NOAA Ship Locations




CY17 Field Season


FY18 Fleet Allocation Plan

FY18 FAP Highlights

- 3026 Planned Days at Sea
- Worldwide Expedition on *Ronald H. Brown* South Africa,
 Seychelles, India, Australia, Hawaii
- Fairweather Continuing Hydrographic Surveys in Arctic
- Thomas Jefferson Returning to Puerto Rico for Additional Hydrographic Surveys
- Okeanos Explorer Beginning ASPIRE project in the North Atlantic
- 50th Anniversary Celebration on *Rainier* and *Fairweather*

FY18 Maintenance Increase

- \$21.5 Million received in April to Address Fleet Deferred
 Maintenance
 - \$5 Million End of year awards for FY19 repair packages: moving execution of packages to the left as much as possible
 - \$3.7 Million towards deferred maintenance
 - \$1.3 Million unscheduled maintenance and repair period growth

Fleet Maintenance Initiatives

- Preventative Maintenance
- Configuration Management
- Inventory Management/Spares Program
- Service Life and Material Condition Assessments
- Long Range Maintenance Plans: FY20 FY29

New Vessel Construction

- \$75 Million for New Vessel Construction
- Bids Received Mid-July, Start Bid Review
- Tentative Plan to Issue Award late September

Summary

- Operational funding to support NOAA Fleet has decreased every year since 2015
- Increase in FY18 maintenance funds will improve reliability rate in the long-term
- Goal to Increase Fleet Execution Rate
