Improve quality of life and morale at sea

Improve quality of life and morale at sea

1) What efforts are currently being made...

- Faster internet was the most common upgrade
- “nothing at all”
- workout equipment - a few said it had happened, though mostly was “needed”

2) What additional changes might be needed...

- Increased budget
- Increasing single berthing spaces
- More bandwidth
- Better common areas/social spaces
- Ships crew work rotations/sailing schedules

3) What resources are needed...

- Money / funding
- Work-Life balance for crew members as well as better wages
- Technology infrastructure (internet)
- Small changes can equal big payout - new linens, mattresses, soundproofing

Next steps

- Faster internet was common theme, but fleet focused on improving that already, so maybe our efforts would be better spent on other elements
- changing 'nothing at all' into something—get institutions where nothing is happening to acknowledge this as a relevant issue
- Revise survey (brainstorm a list of improvements and offer a list for ranking, or...) and take to broader audience (UNOLS members)
