- Completed ~3,000 days of shipboard science in 2021 despite COVID-19
- Still catching up in 2022 on cruises deferred due to COVID-19 with impacts into 2023
- 2022 - ARF completely scheduled in MFP
- 2023 ship scheduling has been in proceeding along – particularly wrt Globals, Ocean & Intermediate class vessels. Kick-off meeting for Regional, Coastal & Local vessels next week
- MFP Cruise Planning module being rolled out to ship operators
- UNOLS Meetings have continued in virtual mode - at least thru April RVOC. We are pressing ahead with a return to in-person meetings starting with DeSSC NUP in May. Annual, Council & FIC meetings will be in Alexandria near NSF 15-17 Nov
- Seeking GW input for the next update to the COVID-19 guidance
- RVSS Updated - 11th Ed – available online, hard copies ready now for distribution to ship operators, facilities, agencies, etc.
