

AICC updates:

- Working on planning/securing funding for a polar early career training cruise on Sikuliaq in 2023
- Ship-based Arctic Science capability is strong:
 - Healy successfully reached the North Pole this summer (3rd time the Healy has reached the pole, 2nd time unassisted)
 - Sikuliaq continues to demonstrate its capability in ice – Spent several weeks in pack ice for AMOS (ONR) mission, and is still(!!) out in the Beaufort Sea conducting CTD surveys, multicoring, and servicing moorings
- USCG planning science focused deployment for Healy every other year (2024 - Arctic West) due to high demand to accomplish many other mission taskings
