Program Overview



- HEALY SLEP is a DHS Level 3 Non-Major Acquisition Program governed by the Executive Oversight Council (EOC).
- The In-Service Vessel Sustainment (ISVS) Program Manager (PM) is Mr. Ken King for HEALY SLEP
- Program funding is part of the ISVS appropriation and managed by the CG-9323 ISVS Program Management Office.
- The HEALY SLEP program goals are to complete the work task to the program.
 - Hull and structural repairs.
 - Replace obsolete and unsupportable equipment.
 - Perform nonstandard maintenance that is beyond the scope of recurring maintenance resources.

Program Activities




- Delayed Initial SLEP Availability to 1QTR FY27
- Continued Nonrecurring Engineering (NRE)
 - NRE is being schedule to support SLEP phased approach
- Planning early deployment of select work items
 - Dual Beam Sonar (FY26)
 - Telephone System (FY24)

Notional Milestone Schedule



Key Assumptions & Applied Best Practices:

- 5 availability "phases" scheduled around planned maintenance periods and recurring Arctic missions in each fiscal year from FY27 through FY31.
- Maintenance periods will include both recurring depot maintenance and SLEP work items.
