
Code of Conduct

- Everyone is accountable: When we as organizers or participants fail to meet these guidelines, we work together to identify problems and adjust policy and practice together.


Ground rules

The issue's / activities that we are working on:

- Federal Government Changes in Priorities
 - Tighten budget less travel, less in-person meetings
 - No refilling Crewing Support Manager position after Meegan Corcoran Departed
 - Not hiring a Safety Manager as was planned and approved
 - Ready to adapt once the funding picture clears up
- Safer Seas Act
 - Moving along smartly with the Ocean and Global class vessels
- Global / Ocean Class Replacement
 - Focus on Global / Ocean class capacity
 - Kilo Moana Replacement
 - FIC reviews / letters to ONR incl review of NOAA shipbuilds



- Marine Facilities Planning (MFP)
 - STILL working to get funding & utilization days correct.
 - Development of new reports
 - Discussions on implementing a Project Support Review & Agreement
 - Regular Cruise Planning Module meetings with operators & developer
 - Stefani Martynenko MFP Customer Service Point of Contact
- Science Requirements for future U.S. Coast Guard Arctic Icebreaker(s)
 - Developing Science Mission Requirements input for "new" USCGC STORIS and future Arctic Security Cutter
- UNOLS Website updated
 - Recently updated new style, cleaner, hopefully easier to navigate



- Ship Scheduling
 - Continued Bi-Weekly meetings for Global/Ocean Class ship schedulers
 - Published most 2025 ship schedules in September 2024
 - Working on 2026 schedules but at slower pace awaiting clarity on federal funding picture
 - Schedulers have prioritized funded SMEs so they are ready to further develop
 2026 schedules once the funding picture clears up
 - Had hoped to move Global/Ocean class scheduling timeline forward for 2026 publish in July 2025 not doable with change in funding outlook
 - Focused on better communicating scheduling status with PIs
- MATE Internship Program
 - 18 Interns in 2024!
 - Anticipate 14 for 2025
- Tech Pool Support
 - 19 Marine Techs Provided in 2024 for 39 Cruises




- Early Career Scientist Cruises
