

NSF Ship Inspection Program

Most Common Findings - Appendix A & B

- Appendix A/B self assessment forms not available. **Only 75% vessel inspected in the past year had completed Appendix A and B self assessments.**
- OHS Manuals - **Only 50% vessel inspected in the past year had developed any OHS Manuals.**
- New - A.5.1.2 Vessel Tension Member Termination Plan
- New - A.5.3.1 Synthetic Tension Member History Logs
- Routine OHS Testing. *Tests must be conducted in a manner that most closely mimics the use of a system or component at sea.*
- Extenuating Circumstances Plan (SOP). *Operators shall develop a procedure on how, and under what circumstances, the vessel will safely continue operations in the event the operating requirements are not met.*
- Keeping up to date with wire and cable lubrication per the Wire Pool Maintenance Policy. About **50%** are in compliance.
- B.5.7.2 An entry must be made in the official logbook prior to departure attesting that the ship's weight handling gear is in compliance with the applicable requirements.
