TERMS OF REFERENCE

Charge of Safety Committee

To provide a forum for the formulation, review, and recommendation for the approval of the UNOLS Research Vessel Safety Standards (RVSS) for the UNOLS fleet through the RVOC.

Membership

- 1. Voting Members- 10 members, representing the UNOLS class of vessels; global, ocean, regional, local, as well polar, regulatory, and RVTEC
- 2. UNOLS Community Members, Federal Agency Reps, Observers all welcome
- 3. UNOLS Subject Matter Experts- non-voting, expertise as needed, invited by committee

Term limits- 3 year with a possible 3 year renewal **Reporting-** This will remain the same, ie. report to RVOC **Meetings-** Twice a year to include RVOC as before



- Revised RVSS approved by RVOC and published
- Committee terms of reference for membership implemented
- Waiver request procedures decided at 2015 meeting implemented with 3 waiver requests considered and acted on.
- Consideration of a formatted waiver request form and evaluation criteria

Safety Committee Outcomes from Monday 18 April 2016

Exemption process & evaluation criteria – Reviewed for submission to RVOC for approval. When approved will be added to RVSS as a new appendix.

Safety Committee membership – call for nominations to fill (3) vacancies.

Appendix B compliance effective July 15, 2016 – Discussed development of tools to assist in compliance with testing procedures. Appendix A training scheduled for May 2016 at WHOI, with a west coast workshop being planned. Appendix B training is being considered for a future workshop.

UNOLS quarterly safety report summaries — Discussed Safety Committee regular review to look for potential trends or areas of fleet wide concern.

Fleet medical training – After discussion, UNOLS Office to create and distribute survey requesting data on current medical training levels; further committee consideration of data when received.

Lithium battery safety – Discussed adequacy of RVSS section 9.4; UNOLS Office to research current standards for committee consideration of possible RVSS update & additional guidance for operators.

Safety Committee Outcomes from Monday 18 April 2016 (Continued)

LCI-90i winch display - UNOLS Office to request RVTEC Chair to collect summaries of reported issues with LCI-90i winch display, and request company response.

Group Purchase Suggestions to RVOC:

- •Alert-2 man overboard beacon system Safety Committee endorsed
- •Jason Cradle man-overboard recovery device Chesapeake Bio Lab to purchase one system to test and provide feedback
- •Wire cutter and weak link Endorsed a group purchase for those that would like them on their ship
