Rich,

WHOI has been using the WXT520's for a couple of years now with good success. They produce "forecast" quality and not "climate" quality data, like the older IMET instruments, however, this is the standard for most of the MET instruments out there anyway. Also, the cost to purchase and maintain them is an order of magnitude lower. Because of this I can put multiple WXT520's on the mast for redundancy. If someone requests IMET instruments we put on a set for that cruise.

If you do look seriously at the Vaisala's don't purchase any of the WXT510's. They had problems with water leakage.
