

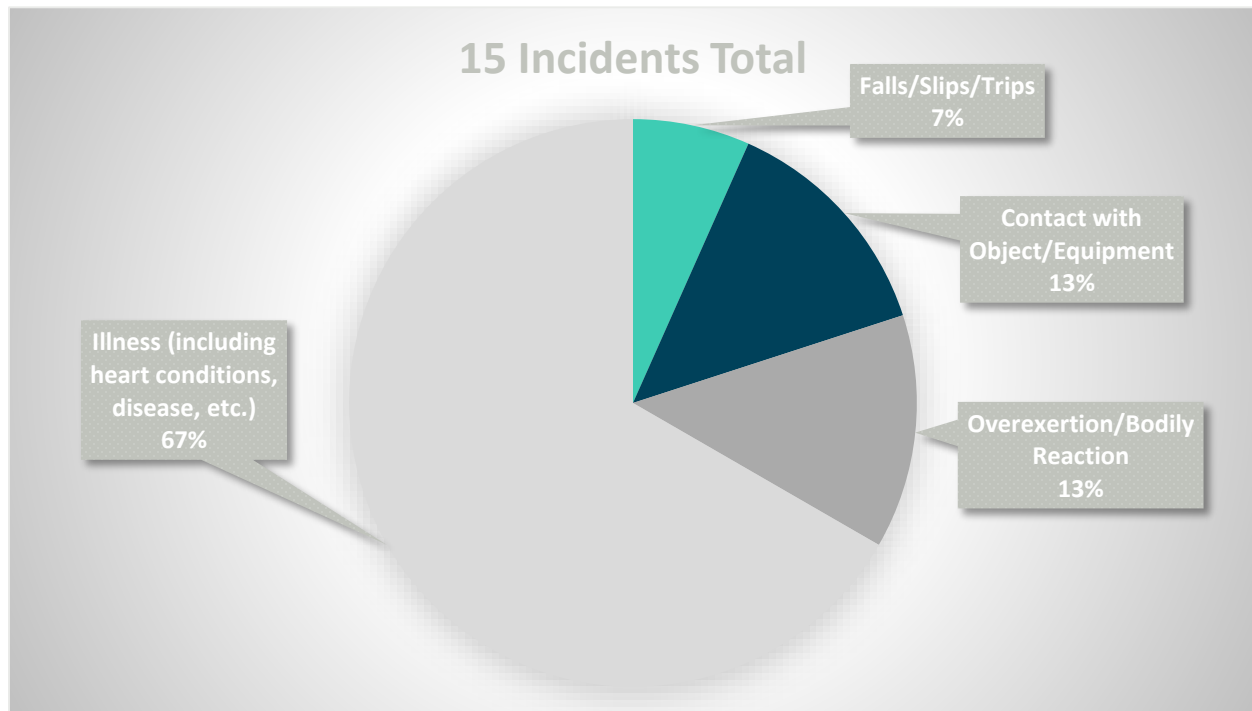

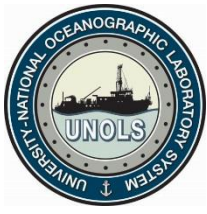
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Incident Details	Warnings/Lessons Learned
<p>The relief 1st A/E was inspecting a piece of equipment and when he stood up lacerated he head on a pipe. The laceration was about 2 inches long, shallow and located on the top of his head. No loss of consciousness. Wound cleaned, dermo-bond applied and monitored for infection. NO lost work time.</p>	<p>N/A</p>
<p>A relief Oiler was working in the engine room, when he reached around the protective guard on a moving piece of equipment to clean up some oil, His left elbow and upper arm came I contact with the moving shaft and he sustained a 5 inch laceration. MAS was notified. the wound was cleaned and Demo-bond, butterflies and Ice applied. An antibiotic was prescribed and he was monitored for infection. NO lost work time and the wound healed well.</p>	<p>A safety investigation was conducted and the entire engine room received a refresher course on safety while working with moving equipment and additional placards were ordered for the area.</p>
<p>Crew member's back muscles tightened while working outside on main deck.</p>	<p>N/A</p>
